High-quality music in combination of the historical setting of the picturesque town of Třeboň offers visitors an unforgettable experience every year. It takes from the year 2004 every year in the second week in July place. In the last time also the concerts of classical music in autumn and winter take under the title Winter Třeboňská nocturna place.

In some years the festival was organized as a crossborder project with austrian partner the city Schrems.

In this year the summer festival will take place from 7. to 11. of July.
