

## Study trip to Boleslawiec (Bunzlau)

**Boleslawiec** (Bunzlau) is a town in the voivodship Lower Silesia. This town is situated approx. 52 km east of Gorlitz and 123 km west of Wroclaw (Breslau) at the Oder river. Boleslawiec has some 40.000 inhabitants and is seat of the surrounding rural community, to which the town does not belong. It is also seat of the district which bears the same name, and to which Boleslawiec town also belongs.

Boleslawiec is well-known for the “Bunzlauer”. Ceramics from Bunzlau had and still have a high economic importance, not only before the end of World War II, but also today. The typical decor of these ceramics contributed to a certain style. Another particular advantage of this pottery is the fire resistance.

Several manufacturers in Boleslawiec are specialised in producing “Bunzlauer” ceramics. There is a revival of ceramics from Bunzlau due to the high quality, which is dishwasher and microwave safe and fire resistant.
